Year 5 Planetarium Trip

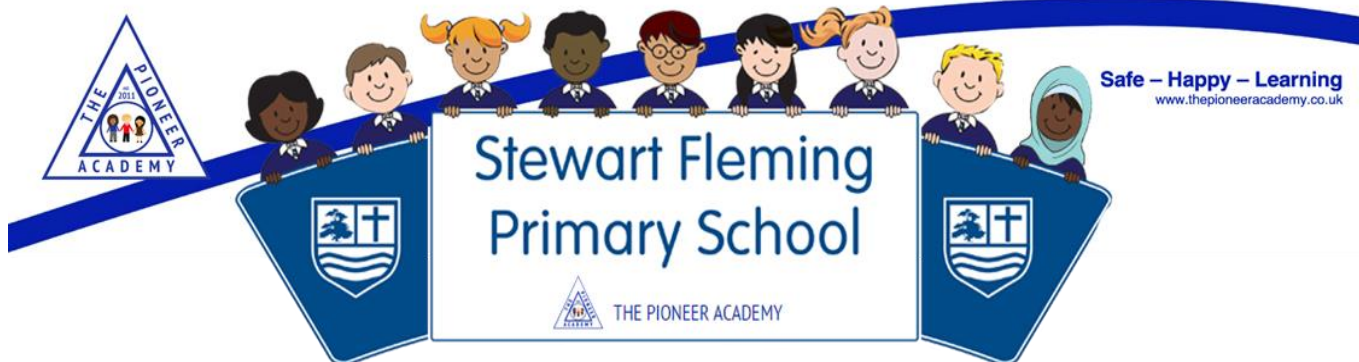
