Appointments

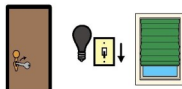
We have noticed that a lot of parents are taking their children out for appointments in the school day. We ask that where possible, children are only taken out for emergency appointments.

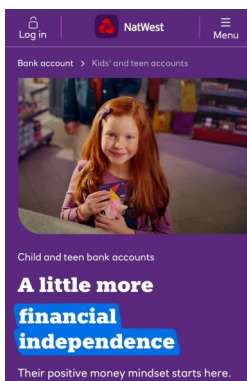

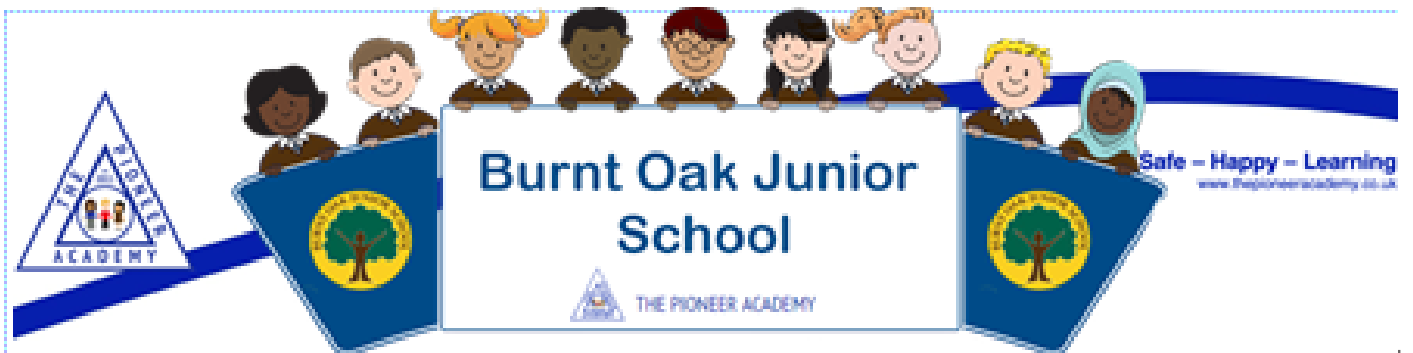
