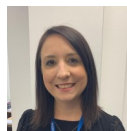




Message from Miss Snow

Attendance

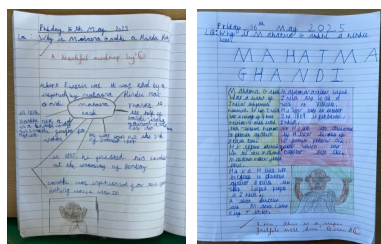
6T were the winners this week with 99.2% attendance. Special mentions to 5S, 4T, 5B and 3T who were just 1% behind them.
