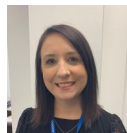




Message from Miss Snow

Wednesday 2nd April—KS2 Bexley Festival of Music (at Fairfield Halls) & English workshop for parents.

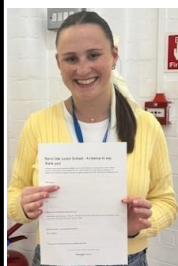
SAFE
