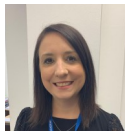




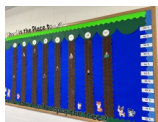
Message from Miss Snow

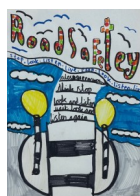
