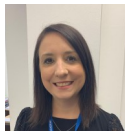


## Message from Miss Snow

All responses are read by Miss Snow and shared weekly with the staff. Thank-you for taking the time.

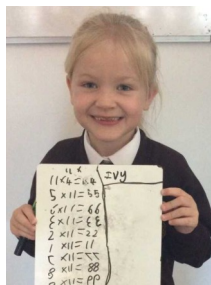
