Year 5 had the opportunity to take part in a workshop about children's rights and the law, delivered by Arthur Templeman-Lilley, an advocate for children's rights and youth participation, and supported by Malvika Unnithan, Assistant Professor at Northumbria Law School. During the session, the children learned about what human rights are and that children have specific rights set out in the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC). They explored who is responsible for protecting these rights and how they apply to real-life situations in their own lives and communities. The children really enjoyed the interactive nature of the workshop, where they were able to make decisions both independently and collectively.
