Safe

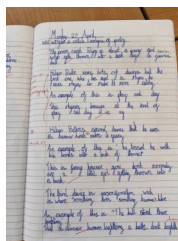
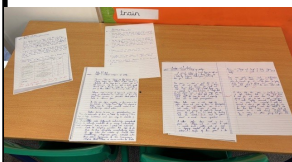
We had an overwhelmingly high number of entries for our Road Safety poster/banner competition. Thank you to everyone who took part and put so much effort into their designs.
